This includes extensive *in vivo* studies in animals ranging from small rodents to non-human primates. Our labs are part of Mount Sinai's Biomedical Engineering and Imaging Institute and we formally collaborate with investigators at New York University, Massachusetts General Hospital, and the Radboud University Medical Center.
